ENTREPRENEUR INTERVIEW SERIES

SUSMITA DASGUPTA PGPM 2005-2006



Courage is what defines Susmita. And she says she owes that quality to Great Lakes. This Great Lakes alumna has had a remarkable journey even before she decided to join Great Lakes. Having nine years of work experience and already heading the marketing division of a USD 4 Billion global conglomerate, she had the vast experience of building multi-sheet financial plans for 27 global factories.

Sharing how Great Lakes started shaping her thoughts right from the beginning, Susmita says, "First, no one was impressed even if I were some CEO of a billion dollar company; because the moment you sat on one of those class benches you are no more some ex-Big Boss but a just fellow student who won't get respect unless he or she has earned it." That's where it all began for Susmita.

While talking about how every course she attended at Great Lakes has molded her, Susmita recollects, "My course with Prof. Paul Prabhakar on marketing and innovation was just Priceless and the course on Re-Engineering Human Potential, a real eye opener. Needless to say, the course on Entrepreneurship gave me hands-on experience in building a business plan and selling my ideas to a bunch of not-so interested buyers and investors."

It was a daring decision that Susmita made in the year 2008, when the market situation was completely downturn. It was conventional wisdom, Susmita remarks which made her embark on a new venture despite the bad times. I would say Great Lakes gave me this courage and ability to think big. Not just big — but BIG, says Susmita. "More than skills, what I gained post Great Lakes is the confidence and ability to set a goal and make it happen. Great Lakes has helped in sharpening my marketing and business skills and has taught me where and how to focus", she adds

Talking about how she drew inspiration at the earlier stages of starting her business, Susmita says that the story she read of Greg Gianforte's RightNow Technologies, has made a lasting impact on her. Greg's mention of how lack of money, employees, equipment, even lack of product is actually a huge advantage was a lesson to me, she says.

Advising aspiring entrepreneurs, Susmita says, "You have to trust your smarts, and take a chance. Bootstrapping a business requires you to clear any clutter from your mind and focus single-mindedly on the Customer." It is important to be creative and to understand whether you have got a real business or just a plausible-sounding business plan, comes the words of wisdom from this gutsy entrepreneur.
