ADMISSION PROCESS PGPM FLEX 2020-22



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

All applicants applying to Great Lakes Institute of Management's PGPM Flex should have -

- Completed a minimum 10+2+3 years of education with an academic track record of 50% throughout
- Should have a minimum work experience of at least 2+ years by June 30, 2020; Candidates with 18-24 months work experience will be considered, if found to be exceptionally good
- For PGPM Flex 2020, we accept CAT*, XAT+, GMAT, MAT or CMAT scores. Candidates who do not have a valid [<2 years] aptitude test score as stated here, would need to take the Great Lakes Aptitude test GREAT as a pre-requisite instead, and would need to get a score acceptable to Great Lakes at their sole discretion, to be eligible for the admission process further

*Great Lakes uses CAT scores only for screening applications for admissions and IIMs have no role in the conduct of Great Lakes academic programs

*Great Lakes is not an associate institute of XLRI but uses XAT scores only for screening applicants for admission & XLRI has no role to play in the conduct of any of Great Lakes Management programs

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Candidates meeting the eligibility criteria can apply to Great Lakes Institute of Management by filling an online application form on www.greatlakes.edu.in after making a payment of INR 1,500
- Candidates have to provide the official email-id of the recommenders. The recommendation letter will be collected online from the recommenders subsequently at a later date
- Candidates will be assessed based on the information provided in the application form and shortlisted for the interview process
- Candidates invited for the Interview will be intimated about the venue and the time slot through E-mail



EVALUATION PROCESS

- Shortlisting based on information provided in the application form
- Screening for academic performance and quality of work experience
- Written Test and Interviews for final selection process
- Assessment of clarity of purpose in pursuing executive management, interview performance and overall academic achievements

Financing Option

There are several ways to finance the PGPM Flex program. Some participants receive full or partial sponsorship from their employers, while others utilize the educational loan provided by banks. The Institute can facilitate financial assistance through educational loans for self-funded candidates. Candidates who receive formal offer Letter are recommended to apply as early as possible.

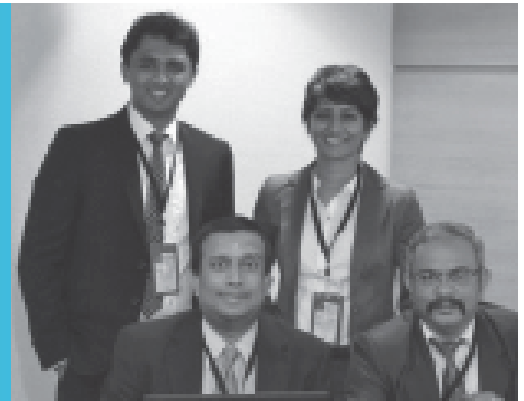

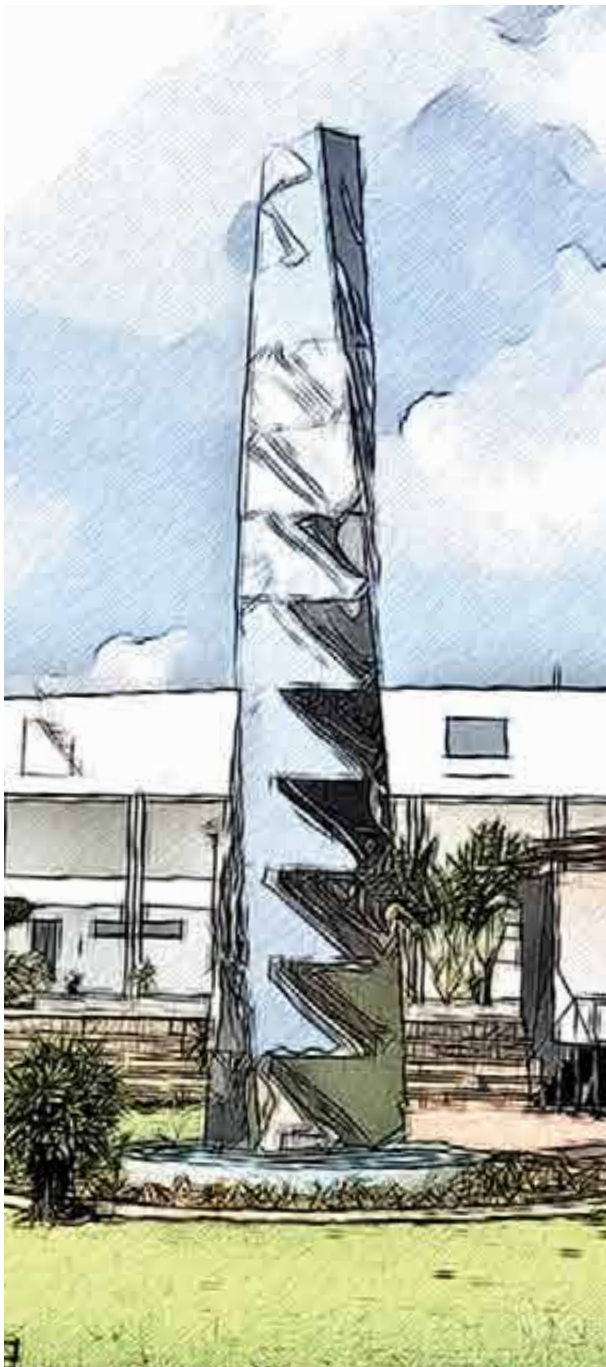
