


Sanchita Tuli Speaks at Panel on Leadership in Higher Education





At Great Lakes, sustainability is not just a concept taught in classrooms — it is a lived value, expressed through mindful action and shared purpose across our community.
















SCORE INDEX INSIGHTS

The SCORE (Sustainability Content Occurrence and Relevance Evaluation) data from July-August 2025 shows a sharp dip in SDG engagement, driven by symbolic rather than sustained coverage. Despite World Population Day (July 11), the index fell by 0.68 (July 7-12) as SDG 3 and SDG 5 awareness remained low, with declines in SDG 4 and SDG 16 offsetting minor gains in SDG 2. The downward trend continued (0.50, July 14-19) before rebounding to 1.32 (July 21-26) around the International Day for the Conservation of the Mangrove Ecosystem (July 26), which boosted SDG 13 and SDG 17 but had limited spillover to SDG 14 and SDG 15.



Key Highlights

- July 28-Aug 2: Sharp drop (1.29) from declines in SDG 1 and SDG 2.
- Aug 4–9: Mild recovery (0.96) driven by SDG 12, ahead of International Youth Day.
- Aug 11–16: Slight dip (0.86) with spikes in SDG 4, SDG 9, and SDG 13 around Independence Day.
- Aug 18-23: Strong rebound (1.46) on renewed focus on SDG 1 and SDG 2.
- Aug 25–30: Major fall (3.02) despite International Day against Nuclear Tests; weak SDG 16 response.
- Overall: Engagement remained event-driven, with focus on poverty, hunger, climate, and education, but lacking sustained momentum.
