The amphitheatre at Chennai's Great Lakes Institute of Management in Chennai is a favourite

Tucked away from the bedlam of the metropolis, the campus of the Great Lakes Institute of Management in Chennai has an air of tranquillity. Spread across 27 acres, this campus is completely eco-friendly and pollution-free. Of the various other hangout spots in the campus, the one that is most preferred is the amphitheatre. Cultural space

"This is quite a de-stress zone," says Natasha, a PGPM student. "The café next to the amphitheatre is open 24x7 and every single person heads to this place during exam time, at any given point at night to relax and take a break. Moreover, the weather here is favourable at most times making it easier for us to walk around," she says.
